DEED OF TRUST

THIS DEED OF TRUST made this 21st day of October, 2009 (Two thousand Nine) by Smt. **NUTAN KUMARI DAISY**, Wife of Sri Bipin Kumar Singh, aged about 39 Years, Occupation- Bussiness, resident of Kalimandir Colony, H.E. School Road, P.O- Dhanbad, P.S-Dhanbad, Dist- Dhanbad (Jharkhand) hereinafter called the "SETTLER" of the ONE PART

Hereinafter called the **TRUSTEES**, nominated by the Settler which expression shall include the survivor or survivors of them and the administrators and executors of last survivors of the trustees for the time being of the trust hereby created) of the OTHER PART

1. The settler hereto above named, has decided to establish a Trust for furtherance of public Charitable benevolent and welfare objects and for such like purpose and objects, the settler has made over a sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) to the Trustees hereto above mentioned, by way of initial contribution.
2. The Trustees have agreed to become Trustees and to hold, apply the said sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) and all contributions, subscriptions and donations received hereafter for public charitable purposes subject to the powers and provisions contained in this deed.

Now This deed witnesseth as follows:

1. **NAME** : The name of the Trust shall be “ **SIDDHARTHA JANKALYAN TRUST**” hereinafter referred to as “TRUST”.
2. **REGISTERED OFFICE**: The Registered office of the Trust shall be situated at H/O Sri Sudhir Singh, Kali Mandir Colony, H.E. School Road, P.O- Dhanbad, P.S-Dhanbad, Dist- Dhanbad (Jharkhand), or at such other place as may decided by the Trustees from time to time with intimation to the concerned authorities in the context.

3. **AIMS AND OBJECTS** : The aims and objects for which this Trust is being formed are :

The Trustees hereby declare that they and the survivor or survivors of them or other Trustee of Trustees hereto for the time being will hold the said sum of Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Eleven thousand only) made over, by the settler to the Trustees as aforesaid and all contributions subscriptions, donations bequeath and other moneys or properties as and when the same shall be paid to acquired by or vested in them and the money, investments and properties and all accumulated income for the time being representing the same and which may from time to time form part of Trust Fund upon Trust for public Charitable purposes to apply the same for promoting humanism, morality, relief to poor, medical relief, education and the advancement of any other object of general public utility not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit in the territories of India, or for a charitable purpose which tends to promote, international welfare in which India is interested, provided, however no part of the said fund or income thereof be applied for any purpose outside India except in accordance with the approval of the Central Board of Direct Taxes/Government of India and for such purpose (Without restricting the generality of the foregoing objects do all or any other objects).

- i. To work based on human values of liberty, equalities and fraternity.
- ii. To create economic opportunities through diversified and nontraditional avenues of employment enterprises generation, skill training as well as to strengthen, rejuvenate and make efficient existing employment.
- iii. To provide for health services, where they do not exist, create access, linkage, demand for existing services where they exist, ensure and strengthen use of indigenous health care and self care system, provide nutrition, immunization, maternal and child care/services/ training/ information awareness.

- iv. Awareness generation and capacity building by undertaking training activities, information dissemination, use of cultural and indigenous media for networking and complaining, creation of instructional and informative material such as pamphlets manuals and material for electronic media.
- v. To undertake non-formal and formal literacy activities so as to strengthen and expand the existing literacy base for capacity building, employment, opportunities and awareness.
- vi. To utilize media and communication as vehicles of social change particularly for alternative development by utilizing indigenous mediums, electronic mediums including, audio, video, documentary and feature films, print and other mediums for portraying value based imagery.
- vii. To provide for social development through dialogue, understanding, co-operation and taking up such activities, imputes that would accelerate social change, Issues concerned rights, enforcement public, creation of alternate paradigms and innovate project models will also be taken up.
- viii. To create awareness on environmental issues, where ever necessary take up social forestry activities and questions including concerns of tribes, schedules castes and other such groups.
- ix. To place special emphasis in all activities on unemployed youth, women and children particularly activities to strengthen their capacities, develop their potential and empower them.
- x. To organise and mobilize women and men for all such activities delineated above and on other relevant issues.
- xi. To provide technical and consultancy services in a wide range of areas such as research and documentation, training, project planning, preparation of audio - video / documentary / feature films on relevant

- XX. To work for all round development of women, children and the un-
educated.
- XXi. To get constructed hostels with the help of local bodies of different
towns, the central and state governments for accommodation of working
women and children.
- XXii. To open schools in different towns and villages for the education of
the general public specially for the women folk to arrange for their training
in spinning weaving, sewing, embroidery, typing and various other
vacation so that they may stand on their own feet and earn their livelihood.
- XXiii. To arrange for the cultural development of children and women.
- XXiv. To initiate steps for providing better information as well as formal
education for students of different sections of the society specially the
weaker section through the network of its institution throughout the
country.
- XXv. To establish start and conduct schools, junior and senior colleges in
all faculties of education and to impart knowledge in every faculty of
education.
- XXvi. To open and run centers, institutions and classes for Educational,
Professional, Technical and vocational courses such as B.Ed., M.Ed.,
B.Tech, journalism, advertising, public relations, Travel and Tourism,
Nursing and Hospital Managing, Electronic, Computer, library science,
Management courses, Export management, Material management,
Garments making, Health care and Beauty parlor, short hand, and Type
writing, Sketching, Painting, Music etc.
- XXvii. To establish, start and conduct computer, electronic, technical,
mining school, Industrial Training etc.

issues as also to self generate resources, as well as provide for infrastructure wherever possible to co-ordinate activities delineated above.

- xii. To publish or to assist in publishing books, booklets, journals, news papers, pamphlets, folders, leaflets, etc for promoting rationalism and humanism and to maintain and conduct printing presses, publishing houses, etc, for that purpose.
- xiii. To organise or assist in organizing seminars, public meetings, lectures, study camps, discussions, conferences, exhibitions and festivals etc. for promoting the main aim of the trust.
- xiv. To establish or assist in establishing Schools, Medical Hospital, Blood Banks, Libraries, Study Centers, Reading Rooms, Science Centers and Museums etc.
- xv. To organise or assist in organising classes, regular or periodical, to conduct examinations, essay, competition, painting, music and drama competitions, etc. to grant certificates and diplomas to award scholarships and make arrangements for training workers and students of rationalist and humanist movement.
- xvi. To establish contact and to co-operate with organizations in India and abroad with similar or complementary aims.
- xvii. To stimulate in the people love for secularism and ideals cherished by founding father of the nation.
- xviii. To give financial assistance or providing legal aid to those who have been proceeded against in any court on account of their having written or spoken for the furtherance or promotion of above objects.
- xix. To interact with various regional, national and international institution for attaining the objects of the trust.

- xxviii. To help and assist poor students to take education by way of cash or in kind and to distribute prizes to outstanding and meritorious students and encourage them.
- xxix. To provide, establish, endow, furnish and fit up with all necessary furniture, instruments and other equipments and maintain and manage school, colleges etc..., particularly in Dhanbad or elsewhere in India for the aforementioned objects and on such terms and conditions as the board of Trustees may prescribe or in which they may be advised to provide accommodation for vocational training, such other causes and facilities for training in various trades and professions.
- xxx. To work for linking literacy/education to the needs of the people subsistence, organization development and transforming actions.
- xxxi. To foster and inculcate the ideas and sense of good citizenship among the children and to make researches to find out means for the education of children so that they may be self-dependent in their life.
- xxxii. To collect and organise exhibitions.
- xxxiii. To undertake or accept the Management of any funds, donations of institutions in furtherance of the objects of the trust.
- xxxiv. To acquire by gift, purchase, lease in exchange, hire or otherwise any property, immovable as well as movable in pursuance of the above mentioned objectives in future.
- xxxv. To construct, alter and maintain any buildings, and/or immovable properties for the purpose of the trust in future.
- xxxvi. To grant relief during natural and National calamities such as earthquakes, flood, flood famine, fire pestilence and other occasions and

to give subscription or contribution to institution, establishments or persons doing such relief work.

xxxvii. To found, establish and maintain museums, emporiums and show-houses for fine Arts, paintings, Antiques, Natural, History, specimens, Mechanical Instruments, Designs, old rare books etc.

xxxviii. To subscribe and grant donations to any local authority or other institution whose objects are similar to objects of the trust.

xxxix. To solicit, obtain or accept subscription, donation grants, gifts, bequests and trusts from any person, firm, corporation, institutions, state or Central Govt. in furtherance of the objects of the trust.

xl. To borrow funds with or without security in a manner the trust may think fit and to repay the same with the approval of the board of trustees.

xli. To look after the welfare and well being of the trust and its properties and to assist and help its member.

xlii. To do all such things as the Board of Trustees may consider necessary incidental or conclusive to the attainment of the aims and objects of the trust.

4. ACCOUNTING YEAR: The accounts of the Trust shall be maintained according to English financial year i.e. (1st April to 31st March) as per English calendar.

5. The number of Trustees shall not be less than two and not more than eleven. The present Trustees named in these articles shall be trustees for their life time but any of them by resign or by giving notice in writing to his co-trustees and shall cease to be a trustee on such resignation.

6. The present trustees named in this deed shall be permanent Trustee and shall not be liable to retire and shall continue to act as Trustee until he ceases to be Trustee or becomes disqualified to act as a Trustee for any of the reasons herein specified in this behalf.
7. The present Trustees names in this deed are founder Trustees who took an active interest in the Establishment of the Trust. Founder Trustees will have membership for life.
8. The Trustees may from time to time appoint any person in their absolute discretion, as Trustees, but in all such cases the approval of the settlor shall be mandatory.
9. The Trustees may, according to such terms and conditions as it shall decide from time to time, admit as PATRON TRUSTEE to those persons who are likely to help in furthering the objects and cause of the trust either through their professional knowledge and experience and/or through financial assistance.
10. The general management and control of the Trust for the purpose of managing the trust affairs and properties (Which may include any business undertaking) and carrying out the objects of the Trust aforesaid shall be vested in the Trustees and without prejudice to the generality of the objects and powers mentioned herein for the purpose of attaining and/or carrying on all or any of the objects specified in paragraph-I above, the trustees shall have power to do the following acts and deeds.
 - a. To accept voluntary donations or contributions in cash or kind from the settler, the member of his family or any other person or concern whatsoever terms and conditions as the trustees may in their absolute discretion think fit and proper.
 - b. To purchase or otherwise acquire lands or buildings and

erect buildings on any land so purchased for the purposes of investment of the trust funds and to spend and/or utilise the rental or other income arising there from for the purpose concerned with or conducive to the promotion of the objects of the Trust in future.

c. To purchase, acquire, hold, manage, improve, develop, exchange, sell, let-out, lease, mortgage, dispose of turn to account or otherwise deal with all kinds of properties movable or immovable, for the purpose connected with or conducive to the promotion of the objects of the trust in future.

d. To borrow land and /or otherwise deal with the money on properties belonging to the trust and to give security or take security in connection with the said dealings or acts in future.

e. To construct alter or keep in repair from time to time building or other immovable property belonging to the trust in future.

f. To make, accept, endorse, discount, execute and issue, promissory notes, Bills of exchange and other negotiable or transfer able instruments.

g. To invest moneys of the trust not immediately required for the purpose in such securities, stocks, shares, bonds or other investments or grant loans with or without security to or in any concern as may from time to time be determined upon and very the same from time to time as may seem expedient at the unfettered discretion of the Trustees.

h. To open accounts with any bank or banks, to operate such accounts and to give instructions to the bank and to provide for opening and operations of such account by one or more of the trustees or by one or more agents appointed by the Trustees.

i. To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration all action suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the properties or affairs.

j. To appoint or make provisions for the appointment of any person (including all or any of the Trustees) committed or administrator or managing trustee or otherwise for the purpose of the administration of the trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may prescribe and also to appoint to provide for the appointment of separate trustees to hold any property or any fund or investments subject of the Trust of this deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the trustees may decide.

k. To make, alter or modify schemes rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and for running any institution in furtherance of the object of the Trust and/or otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the trust.

l. To set apart the whole or part of the income of the corpus or part thereof for any of the objects of the trust.

m. To appoint committee of management for any of the society or institution or organization run by the trust. The members of such committee of management need to be the trustees of the trust. The members of such committee of management shall hold office during the pleasure of the trustees of the trust.

n. The trustees shall be chargeable only for such moneys stocks shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts of commission or omission of the other Trustees or any Bankers or other person with whom the trust proprieties or any

securities may have been deposited or handed over unless caused by their willful neglect or default

11. Resolution in writing circulated amongst all the Trustees and passed by a majority of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been passed in a meeting of the trustees duly called and convened.
12. A trustee who is unable to be present at a meeting of the trustees may send his views on the agenda in writing and such expression of opinion shall be taken to be his vote on the matter concerned.
13. The minutes of the proceeding of every meeting of the trustees shall be in a book to be kept for that purpose and signed by the Chairman of such meeting or of the following meeting when they are over and shall when so recorded and signed by conclusive evidence of the business and other matters transacted at such meeting.
14. 50% + 1 Trustees shall form a quorum for meeting for the Trustees and in case of difference of opinion amongst the Trustees in any manner, the Opinion of the majority shall prevail and the dissenting Trustees shall be bound to join in the act which may have to be performed by the trustees in pursuance of such decision PROVIDED HOWEVER that in the case of equality of votes the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
15. Should any of the property belonging to the Trust fund be acquired by the Government or other public body or bodies the Trustees shall be entitled to withdraw the compensation allowing in respect thereof and to invest the compensation money in such manner as these shall think fit.
16. The Trustees shall keep or cause to be kept proper books of account wherein shall be kept an account of the Trust receipt and disbursements and shall appoint a chartered Accountant to be the auditor of the Trust fund and shall have the accounts audited by the said auditor once to least every year.

17. The Trustees or trustees of these presents for the time being may reimburse himself or themselves and pay and discharge out of the Trust Fund or moneys in their hands all expenses incurred in connection with the execution of presents. The trustees will not be however, entitled to receive any remuneration for their service as Trustees.
18. That, receipts granted by any one of the Trustees for any moneys, stocks, funds, shares, securities or investments paid, delivered or transferred to the Trust in exercise of the powers hereof shall effectually release and discharge the person or persons paying delivering or transferring the same there from and from seeing or from bound to see the application there of or being answerable for the loss of misapplication thereof.
19. Any conveyance, Mortgage, Re-conveyances, lease or any other deeds, documents and assurance what so ever may be signed executed and registered by the two Trustees or more of the trustees as may be authorized by a resolution of the Trustees in that behalf and such conveyances, Mortgage, Reconveyances, lease or other deeds, documents and assurances so signed by any two or more of the Trustees shall be deemed to be signed executed and registered by or on behalf of all the Trustees for the time being.
20. The Trustees may delegate any of their powers to one of the more committee or sub-committee consisting of such persons or person from amongst themselves as they may think fit and such committees or sub-committees shall function subject of such rules or directions as may be prescribed or given for the purposes by the Trustees from time to time.
21. The Trust is hereby expressly declared to be a public charitable Trust and all the provisions of this Deed are to be constructed accordingly.
22. Nothing contained in this deed shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to do any act which may in any way be constructed as violative

or contrary to the provisions of sections 2(15), 11 and or 13 of the Income Tax Act, 1961, and/or any statutory modifications thereof.

23. On the termination of the trust no part of the trust property shall be paid of applied for the benefit of the trustees or beneficiary of any private individuals and all such assets after paying the debts of the trust shall be conveyed, transferred and assigned to such charitable Trust having their aims and objectives similar to the trust as the trustees in their absolute discretion determine, and in case no such charitable institutions having the similar aims and objectives of the trust is found, the entire property including movable and immovable will stand conveyed; transferred and assigned to an appropriate authority and trust etc which would be determined by a resolution to be adopted by the majority of Board of Trustees in that eventuality.

24. As long as the settler shall live and be able to act in the matter, he shall remain one of the trustees and shall be entitled to preside at all meetings of the trustees and of the trust unless prevented to do so by any rule of law he shall have a casting vote also.

25. The Trust does not hold any movable or immovable property as on the date of its registration excepting Rs. 5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand) only contributed by the settler to the Trustees by way of initial contribution.

All the powers and provisions hereof shall be constituted as being subject to the restrictions and limitations herein contained.
